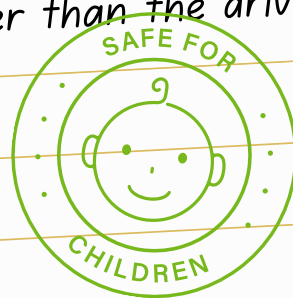
# Stay and Play


